FEBRUARY SPEAKER: JUSTIN EVERETT

Justin Everett is a candidate for HD 22 and was the speaker for the February meeting. Justin held an informal meeting and discussed some of the bills currently being proposed by our State legislature.

He has been active in conservative politics and public policy since the 1980s. Enamored with Ronald Regan after watching him speak on TV at the 1980 Republican National Convention, and meeting former U.S. Senator Bill Armstrong

in 1984 have been the two greatest factors shaping Justin's politics. He has held various positions in the Republican Party, including working for the Republican National Committee in Washington, DC after they captured Congress in 1994, he was a National Delegate in 2004, Teller Committee Chair for the 2004 Jefferson County Assembly, is a District Captain and Precinct Committeeman and has worked on many campaigns as both paid staff and volun-
